

Benin's Proposal for Family Planning Commitments

Benin has undertaken a process for refining its National Action Plan budget for family planning. If all goes well, this will be available by the end of December.

Objective

Increase mCPR to 20 percent by 2018

Political commitments

Disseminate the National Population Policy Declaration (DEPOLIPO)

Revise policies, norms and protocols to strengthen delegation of tasks

Disseminate Law on Reproductive Health and regulations

Develop a contracting process with the private sector within the family planning framework

Financial commitments

Progressively increase through 2018 the amount allocated for the purchase of contraceptive products to **CFA 250 million**

Commitment fulfillment/programming

Assure the availability and accessibility of contraceptive products throughout the country through community networks

Make access to modern methods of contraception free by 2015 within the framework of public health training for adolescents and youth

Strengthen communication around family planning, notably among target groups (women expressing an unmet need [for family planning], adolescents and youth...)
