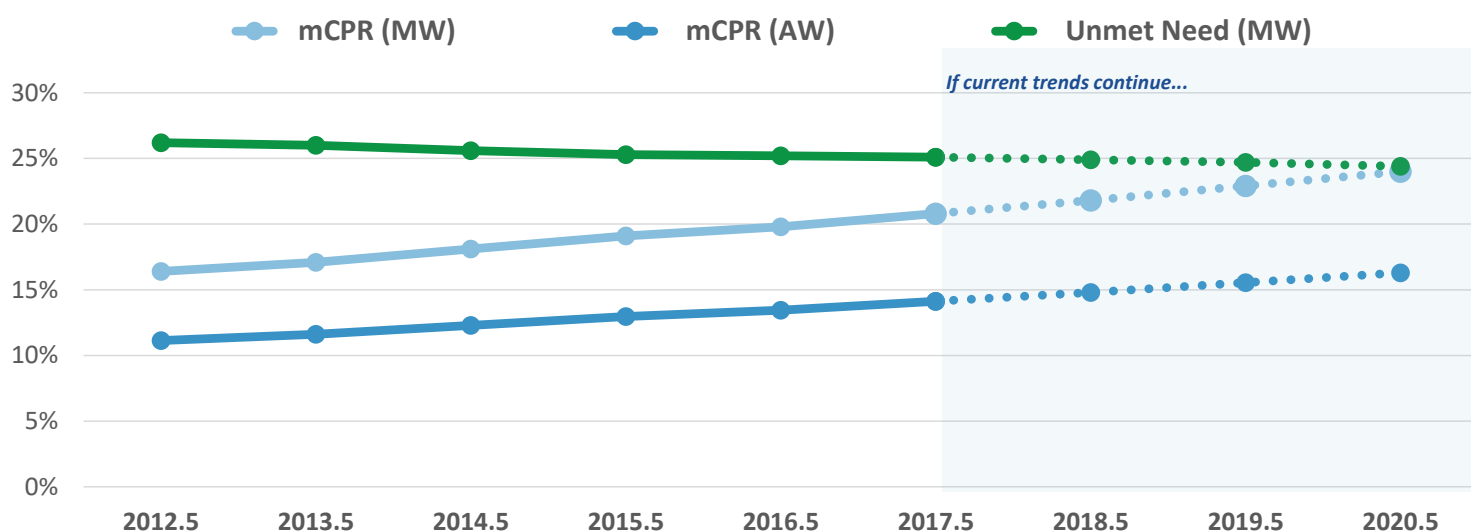

unintended pregnancies prevented (#6)

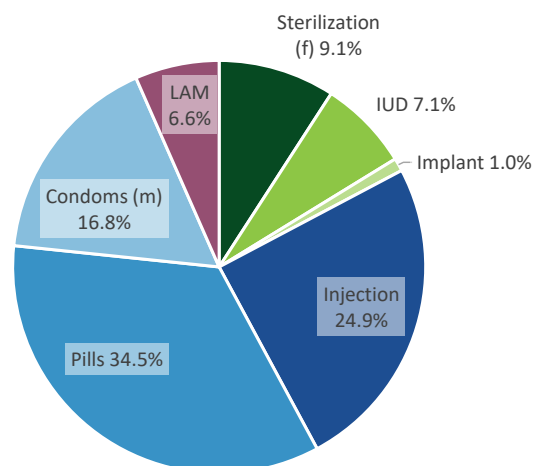
**84,000**
