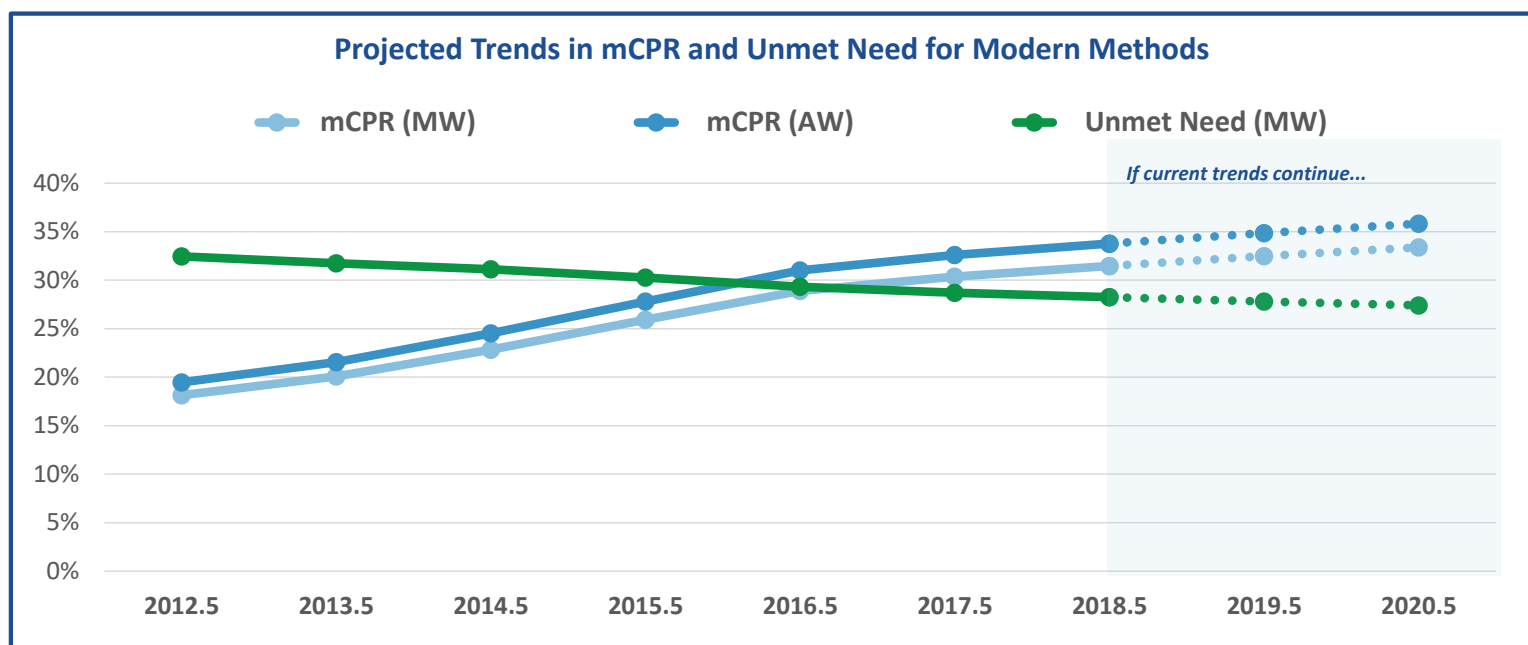

| #4 | Demand Satisfied for Modern Contraception (MW) | 52.7% | 54.9% |

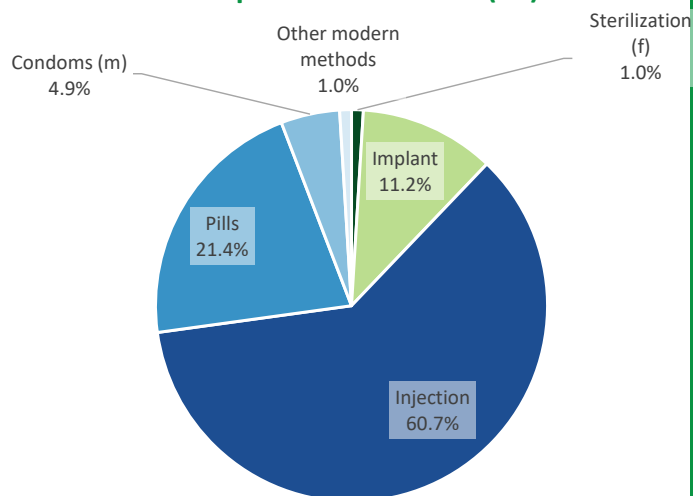
