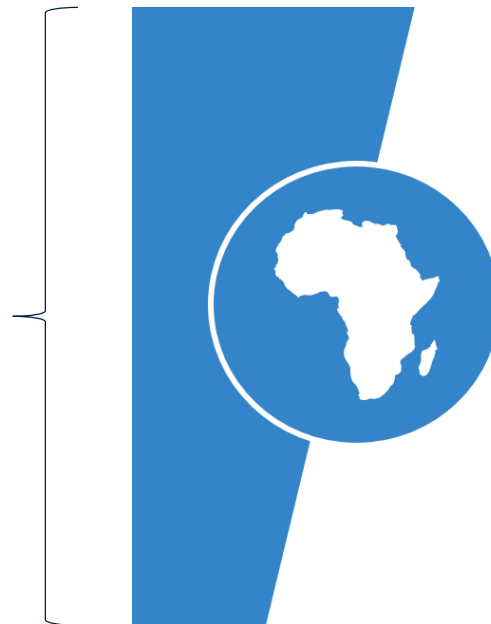

GFF Expansion and HCP

- GFF expansion will take place in the next 6 months among 8-14 countries.
- Expansion criteria includes bottom 30 on Human Capital Index.
- Other criteria heavily correlated with large gaps between demand and use of modern methods.

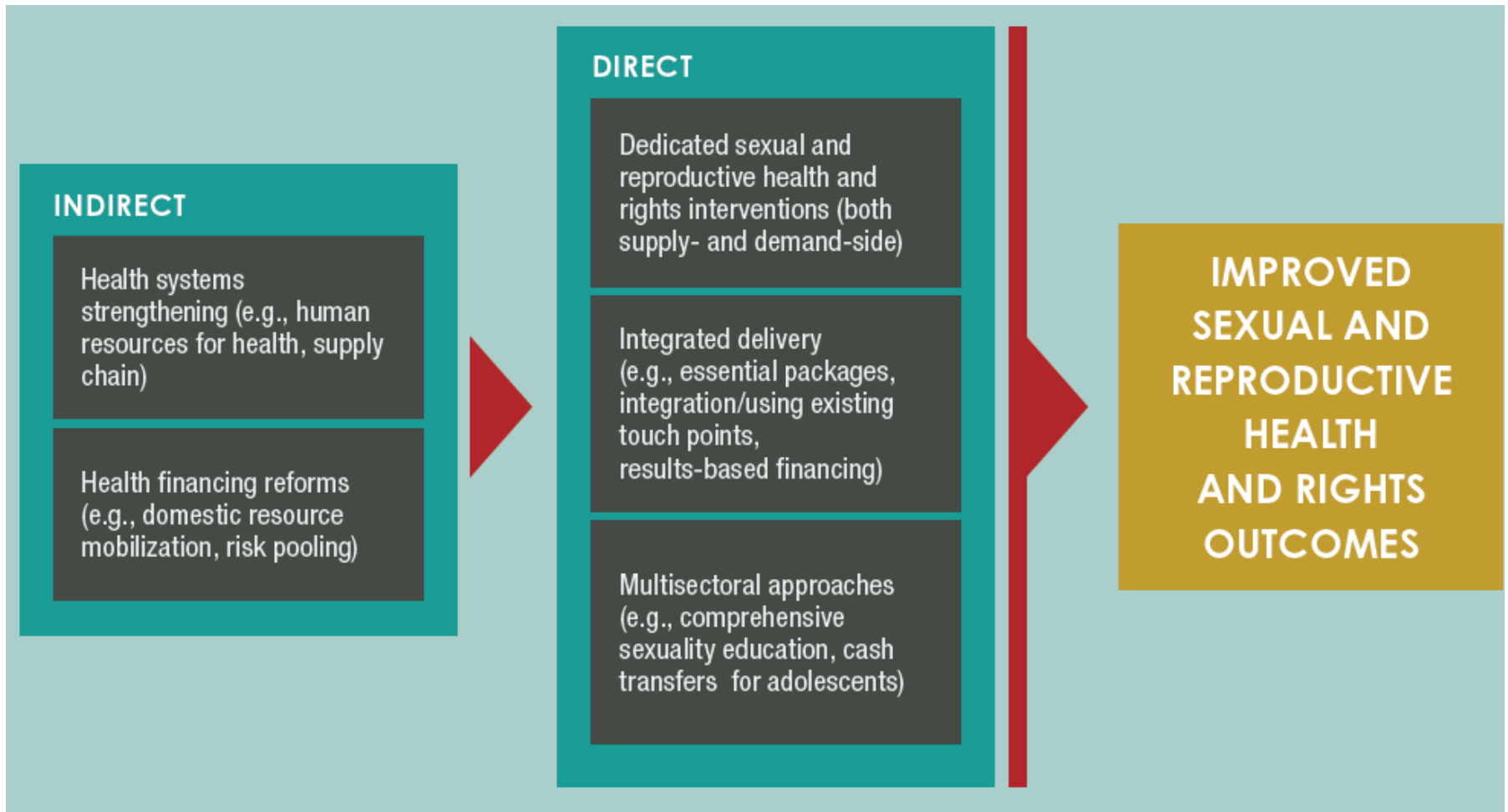

Where can the GFF add value as a partnership? Addressing three constraints:

- 1. Evidence for ASRHR interventions has improved dramatically in recent years but key gaps limit choice of intervention, implementations in new contexts, and scale.*
- 2. Many health and social service systems lack the financing instruments to use resources in ways that respond to ASRHR needs.*
- 3. There is a need for multi-sectoral responses and accountability to maximize potential financing and impact for ASRHR outcomes.*

Strategic Purchasing Strategy:

Provincial service delivery contracting (BPHS)

Supply-side intervention:

Expansion of method mix purchased under BPHS;
Strengthening contractor support for community-based counselling and service provision.

Measurement: Pilot client experience measures in the balanced-scorecard used to monitor BPHS implementation.

Cameroon



Strategic Purchasing Strategy:

Facility-based PBF

Supply-side intervention:

Tablet-based counselling support tool;

Measurement: pilot of phone-based and community-based follow-up and client experience measurement, with validation against contraceptive continuation.
